

Christmas Stockings

Inspired by the characters in Walt Disney's
SANTA CLAUSE 3: THE ESCAPE CLAUSE

SANTA CLAUSE Real Stitch Stocking

YOU WILL NEED:

- Construction paper (red and white)
- Hole punch
- White yarn
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Tape



- 1) Tape 2 pieces of red construction paper together on all corners.
- 2) Draw your stocking pattern on one side.
- 3) Use your scissors to cut along the line of your pattern.
- 4) Fold one white sheet of paper in half.
- 5) Draw a 8 to 10 cm rectangle with rounded corners slightly longer than the width of the top of your red stocking pattern.
- 6) Stack your 4 pieces of paper together in the correct order and tape them in place.
- 7) Mark dots along the sides of your stocking pattern. Place your dots 15mm inside your pattern every 2cm.
- 8) Wrap a piece of tape around one end of your yarn to a tapered point (this will allow you to thread the holes)
- 9) Thread your yarn through the holes starting at the top back corner of your stocking (your yarn should always pass through the same side of your pattern and wrap around the outside)
- 10) When you reach your final hole string your yarn back across the top of your stocking to the hole you started at. (this exposed piece of yarn should face the wall when displayed)
- 11) Tie one end of your yarn to the other, on a knot, leaving about 15 cm on either side.
- 12) Tie the two loose ends together creating a loop for hanging.

You did it! Merry Christmas!

JACK FROST Decorative Stocking

YOU WILL NEED:

- Construction paper (blue and white)
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Pencil
- Tape



- 1) Tape 2 pieces of blue construction paper together on all corners.
- 2) Draw your stocking pattern on one side.
- 3) Use your scissors to cut along the line of your pattern.
- 4) Fold one white sheet of paper in half.
- 5) Draw a rectangle slightly longer than the top of your stocking pattern and 14 cm wide with your fold located lengthwise.
- 6) Cut out spikes along the length of your rectangle opposite the folded edge.
- 7) Assemble your pattern pieces by placing the tops of your two blue pieces up inside the fold of your white jagged piece.
- 8) Hold all your pieces together at the folded top with one hand.
- 9) Use your other hand to staple them together at the top.
- 10) Staple all around the outside edge of your stocking about 5mm from the edge.
- 11) For your hanger: cut out a piece of yarn or string and tie it into a loop or cut out a paper loop and attach it to the top back corner of your stocking with tape or a staple.

Now you've done it!
We won't let this get around to Santa.
